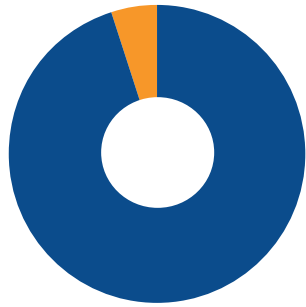

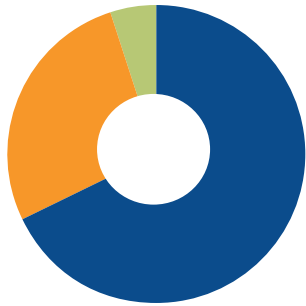

### EMPLOYMENT STATUS

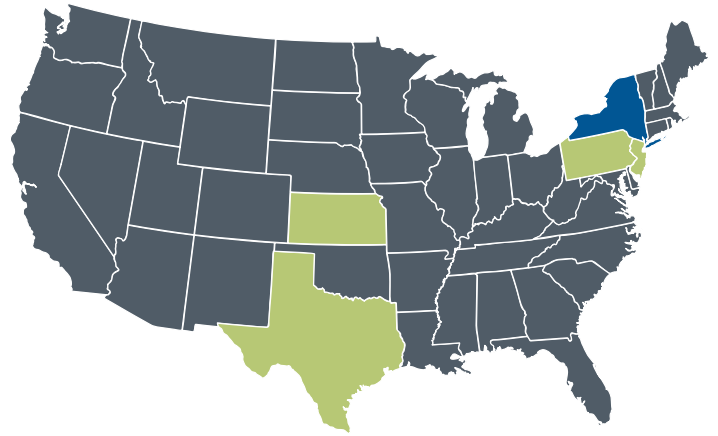

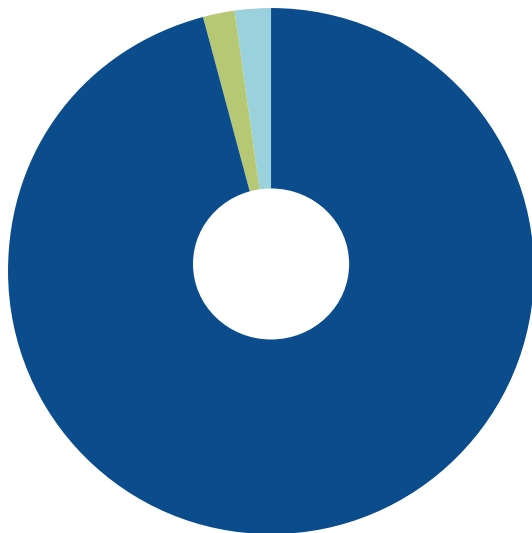

### LOCATION OF EMPLOYMENT



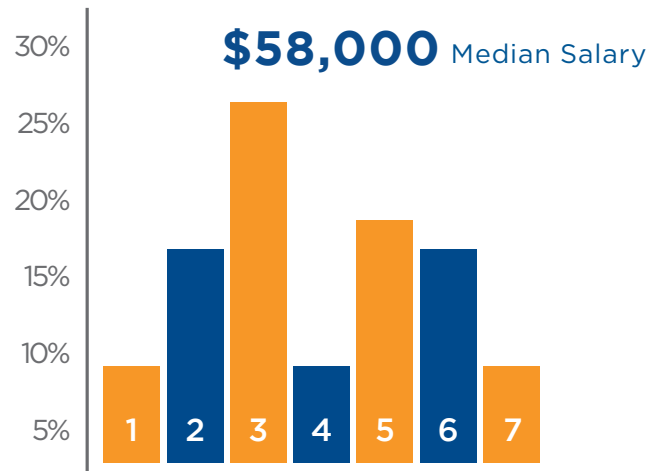
