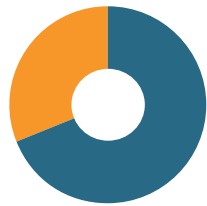
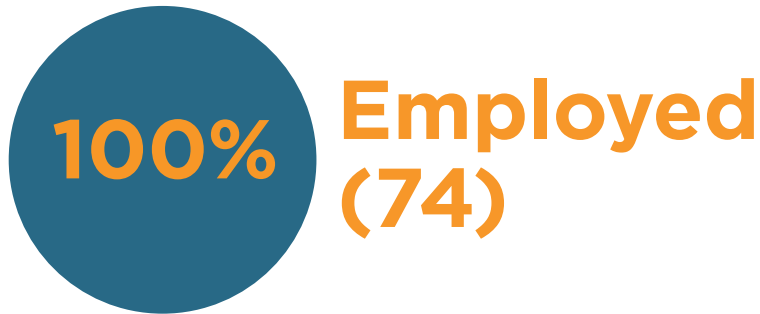

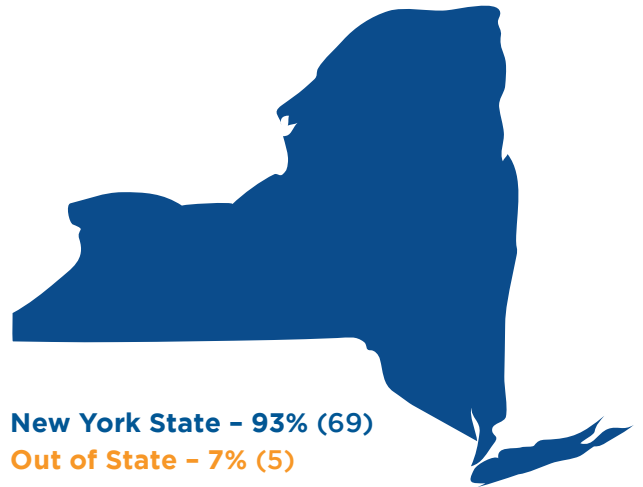
### EMPLOYMENT STATUS



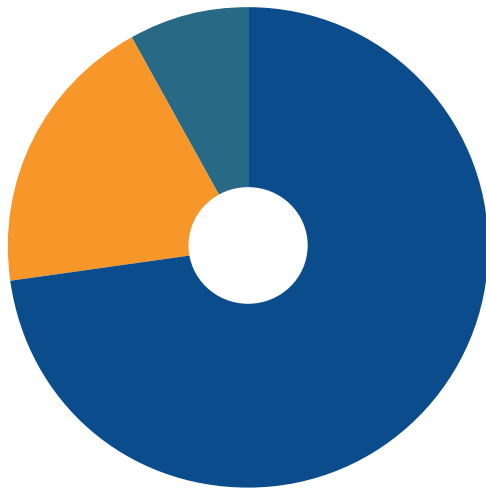
69% Continuing Work with Pre-Graduate Employer\* (51)

### EMPLOYMENT SECTORS



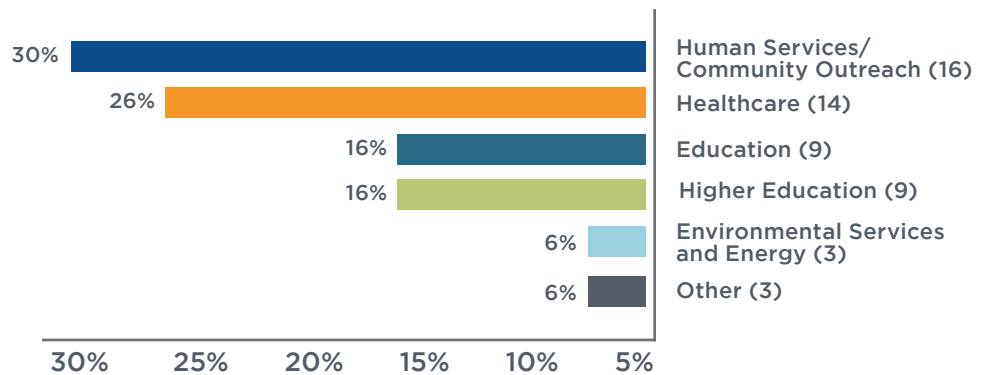
