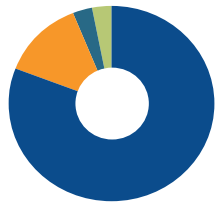

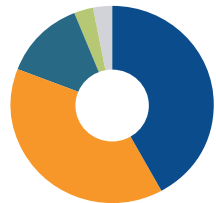

EMPLOYMENT STATUS

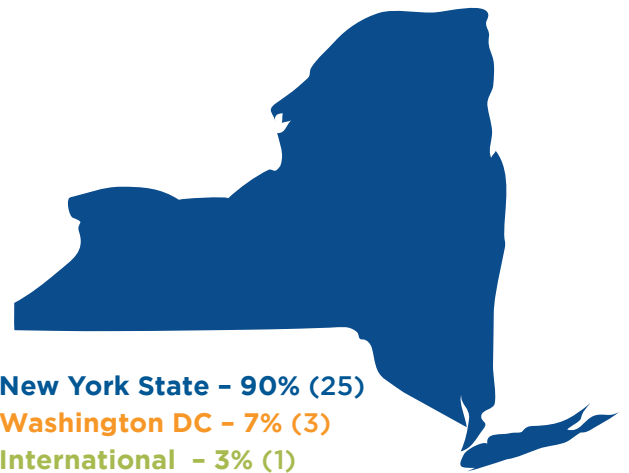

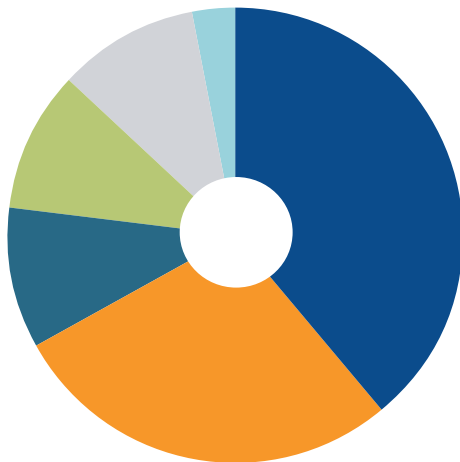

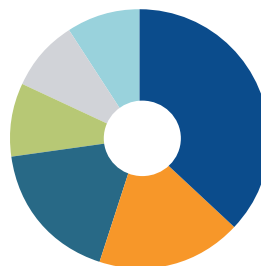
