## OPTIONAL MPA Concentrations

*(For students who entered the MPA program prior to Fall 2022)*

All MPA students must complete SIX (6) elective courses (or 18 elective credits) towards their degree program, regardless of whether they choose a concentration or not.



If a student chooses a concentration, 4 of their 6 electives (or 12 of their 18 elective credits) must be chosen from a selected list, depending on the chosen concentration.



If the student does not want to concentrate in a particular area, s/he can choose any 6 graduate electives (or 18 credits) offered by the Marxe School, in consultation with an advisor, to complete degree requirements.
