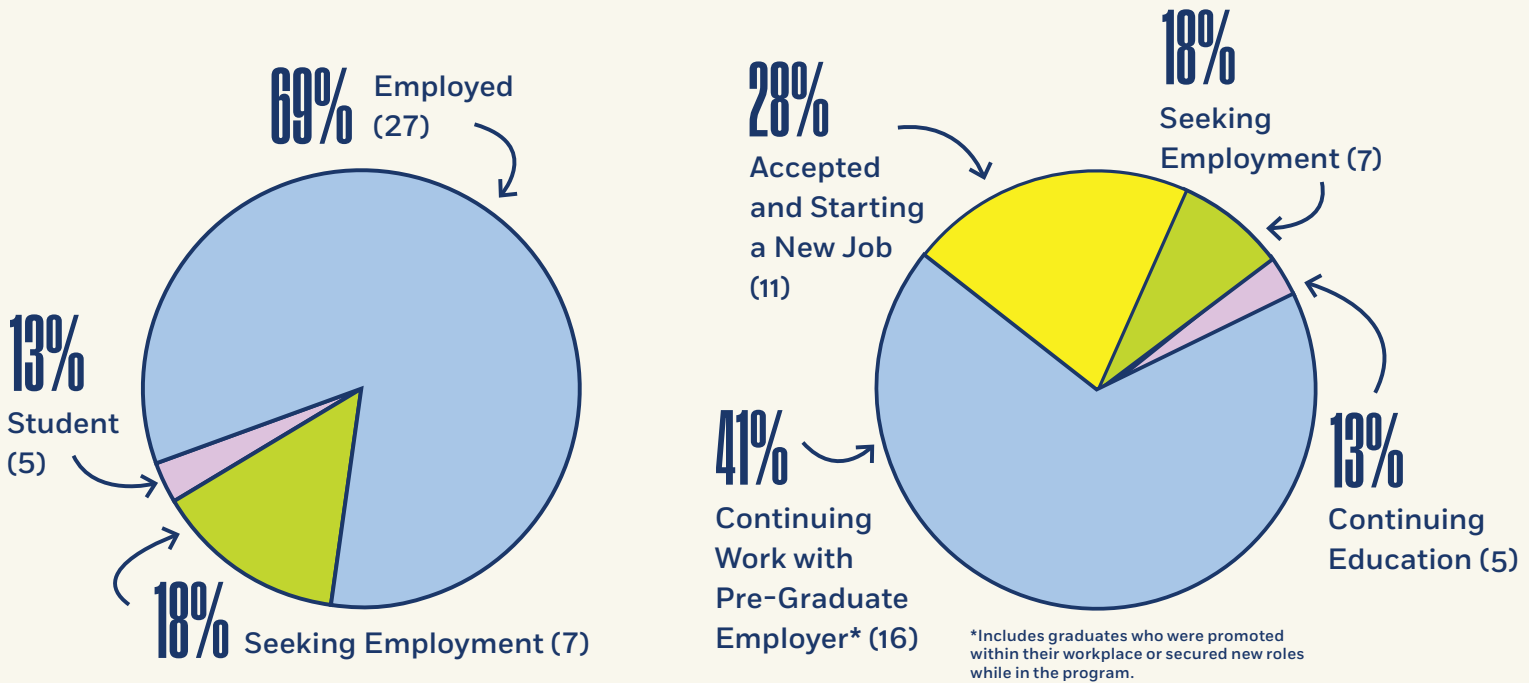

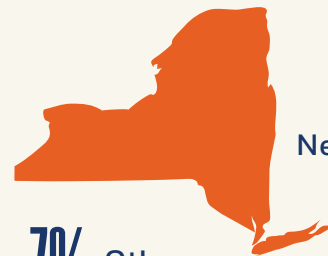

ABOUT THE MARXE SCHOOL OF PUBLIC AND INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

The Austin W. Marxe School of Public and International Affairs is New York City's premier public graduate school dedicated to public affairs and administration, drawing upon one of the nation's most accomplished and active faculty bodies, and applying an interdisciplinary approach to teaching, research, and professional development. Marxe's mission is to educate and empower leaders, advance knowledge about societies and policies, and engage diverse communities across New York City and the world to develop inclusive, adaptable, and effective institutions.

Since 1994, the School has offered the undergraduate BSPA degree, a graduate-level MPA degree in public policy and administration, and an MEd in Higher Education Administration (MEd-HEA). In Fall 2017 the Master of International Affairs (MIA) degree program was launched. An Online Master of Public Administration (OMPA) was launched in the Fall of 2024. The Master of Science in City Planning (MSCP) will launch in the Fall of 2025. There are also two certificates to choose from: the Certificate in Public Communication, and the Certificate in Quantitative Methods for Policy and Equity Analysis.
